ACADEMIC ACCELERATION FOR ADVANCED LEARNERS REFERRAL FORM ABOUT EARLY ENTRANCE

Some considerations: My child: ☐ Has one or more older siblings in the grade in which he/she will be placed if admitted by early entrance which may cause social/emotional issues in the family. In which case, acceleration may not be advisable. ☐ Often did not want to attend preschool or missed preschool often because of illness or family issues. I believe that my child exhibits a number of the characteristics listed above that indicate he/she might benefit by entering the grades K-12 program. I have reviewed the considerations and do not feel they would negatively impact my child's success in school. I request evaluation for my child for possible early entrance to kindergarten or first grade.
