WHEREAS, R.C. 3313.90 also provides that the requirement for a school district to provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight can be waived for a particular school year if the school district's board of education adopts a resolution that specifies the district's intent not to provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for a particular school year and submits that resolution to the Ohio Department of Education by the thirtieth day of September of that school year.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Board will not provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for the 2017-2018 school year.
- 2. The Board directs the Superintendent or his designee to submit a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Department of Education prior to September 30, 2017.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the LaBrae Board of Education hereby agrees to participate in and enter into a cooperative agreement contract with the Trumbull County Educational Service Center, other Participating School Districts and Community Bus Services, Inc., for the transportation of disabled students attending cooperative special education classrooms out-of-district in Trumbull County, effective July 1, 2017.
