#### **STUDENT MEDICATIONS;**

Any medications in the clinic must be picked up **<u>BY AN ADULT</u>** no later than Noon on Friday, May 27th. Epi Pens and Inhalers will be sent home with the student. All unclaimed or expired medications will be thrown out.

Parents, Clinic forms for the 2016-2017 school year regarding medical conditions and medications **will be mailed home for students in grades 3 - 12.** Please complete and return these forms by the first day of school. There will be a collection box for clinic forms and medications in the main office of each building. You may drop off forms and medications starting August 17, 2016 prior to the first day of school for students. <u>Students entering kindergarten</u> who did not have an up to date shot record at the time of registration should also return their shot records to the collection box in <u>the Bascom Office. Students entering 7th grade</u> need to have documentation of having received their <u>Td, Tdap booster shot and Meningitis Vaccine.</u> Any student entering 12th Grade also needs a Meningitis Vaccine. Having these forms in place when school starts is essential in helping us keep your children safe at school. Thank you for your cooperation!
