### MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parent/Guardians:

I would like to thank the community and parents that supported our 6th grade camp through the purchase of mums. The cost of camping experience continues to rise and without your support it might not happen. The middle school normally runs one fundraiser per year aside of the mum sale. All proceeds from the middle school fundraiser go right back into the school in the form of technology, workbooks, and other educational supplies.

To the parents of the 7th grade students, Ohio Schools are required by law to show proof of immunizations for TDap and Meningitis Virus. This is not new, but it becomes problematic for parents and students. There are currently over half of our 7th grade students that do not have the documentation of proof. We start informing students about this in 6th grade. The original due date is September 30th. I can extend that date by a week or so, but I need this information as soon as possible. The students that did not have their shot record on file were called down and given a letter/reminder to take home. I need your help in getting these shot records.

Student picture day was held on October 3rd this year. Parent-teacher conferences will be held on October 12th from 2-9pm. Middle and high school students will be released at noon on the 12th. Student interims were sent home on September 27th. I strongly encourage that all parents review the interim and schedule a conference regardless of your child's marks. Conference night is about finding ways to help students to work to their potential. They are not designed to point out the missing qualities, but instead on how to find them. Conferences are set up in 15 minute blocks with every teacher your child has. A conference with one teacher is a conference with all teachers at that grade level. Please call and make an appointment today. It is an important event during the school year. The 1st nine weeks ends on October 27th with report cards going home on November 3rd.
