

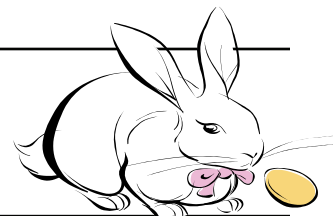

Dear Parents/Guardians: State Testing for the 2012-13 school year begins on April 22nd. Students in grades 6-8 will test Monday through Wednesday with make-ups on Thursday and Friday. Students in 6th and 7th grade will take two tests while 8th graders will take 3 tests. Additional information will be provided as we move closer to our testing dates. Students in academic trouble for this school year will be notified at school and a letter will be sent home notifying parents.
