MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear LIS Parents/Guardians:

The Intermediate school students have completed their performance based assessments for both PARCC and AIR. They worked really hard at taking these assessments on the computer. The end of year section of these tests will be administered beginning the week of April 20th. Please see your student's calendar in their STAR Binder for exact days and times that they will be tested. We are being told that we will not receive the results of these tests until the beginning of next school year.



The 3rd grade students will take the Reading OAA (paper and pencil assessment) on April 21st. The students took this assessment back in October and the state will take the higher of the two assessments scores as the final score. The results of this test will be mailed home this summer.

Due to the amount of calamity days the district has had to use this year, there will be an additional three days added to our school year. The students' last day of school for the 2014-2015 school year will now be June 2nd. If there are further calamity days, they will also be added onto the June 2nd date. Let's hope that is not the case and that April will bring us some warmer temperatures and sunny days.
