## MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parent/Guardians:

I would like to thank everyone that supported the middle school fundraiser last month. The middle school made about \$2,200.00. This money is deposited into the principal's fund and ends up back into the classrooms in the form of technology, workbooks, support for field trips, etc. We generally hold one fundraiser per year and your continued support makes it successful.

The third grading period ended on March 29th. Report cards will be sent home with students on April 5th. I will be reviewing every report card for failing marks. Students with 2 or more failing marks in their content areas will be called to the office for a conference. A letter will also be mailed home to parents telling them now about potential retentions.
