This month we will begin state testing for grades 6-8. We will test by grade level beginning at 8:00 am on the designated day of testing.

- 6th Grade ELA 4/19 part 1 and 4/20 part 2
- 6th Grade Math 5/3 parts 1 and 2
- 7th Grade ELA 4/23 part 1 and 4/26 part 2
- 7th Grade Math 5/4 parts 1 and 2
- 8th Grade ELA 4/21 part 1 and 4/22 part 2
- 8th Grade Math 5/5 parts 1 and 2
- 8th Grade Science 5/10 parts 1 and 2

The testing data should return to the districts by June 30th.

I have also ordered the 6th grade Cogat aptitude test. This test will be administered to the 6th grade student population. This test is a multiple choice assessment that measures reasoning skills. The assessment is used to identify gifted students in the 6th grade. The tests have been ordered but have not yet arrived at the school. I will communicate through Final Forms when I have an actual testing date. All testing serves the purpose of determining student progress, finding strengths/weakness, and identifying gifted students. Testing results are used to improve teaching and learning.
