7:30 p.m. - Second Grade

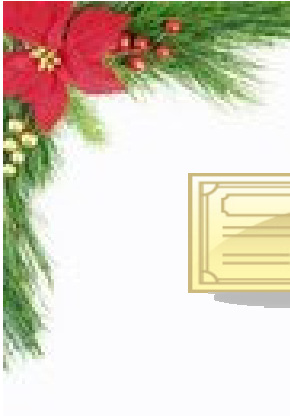

## Christmas Program News



***Bascom's Christmas Program at the High School Auditorium. December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2012***

***Grade level and Times are as follows:***

***Kindergarten-*** will start at 5:30 p.m. arrive at 5:00-5:15

***First grade-*** will start at 6:30 p.m. arrive at 6:00-6:15

***Second grade-*** will start at 7:30 p.m. arrive at 7:00-7:15

*CHILDREN ARE TO BE TAKEN TO THE HIGH SCHOOL CAFETERIA TO MEET THEIR TEACHERS.*

*PLEASE TAKE YOUR CHILD'S COAT WITH YOU AS YOU GO TO TAKE YOUR SEAT IN THE AUDITORIUM.*

*PARENTS: FOLLOWING THESE GUIDELINES WILL CREATE LESS CONFUSION AND A SAFER PROGRAM FOR OUR LITTLE PERFORMERS.*

### **DISMISSAL AFTER EACH PROGRAM**

*(1) Students will be dismissed first from the stage to go to the Jr. High gym.*

*(2) **Parents will all exit stage left** after all the students are dismissed. Next show will enter from the right doors.*

*(3) Parents will pick up and sign out their child in the Junior High gymnasium with the teacher. **PLEASE DON'T TAKE YOUR CHILD WITHOUT SIGNING THEM OUT WITH THE TEACHER.***

*(4) Dismissed to your cars.*

*The parents coming for the next show, DOORS WILL OPEN 20 minutes before the next show. There will be plenty of room and good seats since all performances are separated. If you have children in two different grades you don't have to leave and reenter. You can stay where you are in those seats just pick up your child and have them sit with you for the next show.*
