Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, April 9, 2018, in the Complex Band Room, and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the March 12, 2018 Board Meeting.
- Approved the March Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the payment of March Bills as presented by the Treasurer.
- Accepted the resignation of Donna Bollinger, an Intermediate teacher, effective June 1, 2018.
- Awarded a high school diploma to James Robert Aldridge Jr., a veteran of the Korean War, per O.A.C., O.R.C., and LaBrae Board policies.
- Authorized participation in the Title I, Title II-A, Title II-D, Title IV, Title IV-A, Title V, IDEA-B, and Intervention federally funded programs for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Approved a memorandum of understanding with Youngstown State University for the College Credit Plus program for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Approved limited and continuing contracts for classified staff as presented.
- Approved a policy of paying substitute route drivers a substitute rate equal to 90% of the current step one hourly driving rate negotiated with OAPSE Local 278 once a driver achieves the 26<sup>th</sup> full day of service in a fiscal year, effective April 2, 2018.
- Approved athletic supplemental contracts for the 2017-2018 school year.
