Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, April 12, 2021, in the Complex Auditorium, and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the March 8, 2021 Regular Board Meeting.
- Approved the March Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the Fiscal Year 2022 Excess Costs Foundation Contract with the Trumbull County ESC for \$1,036,325.00 to be deducted from State foundation payments to the LaBrae Local School District.
- Approved a resolution endorsing the Fair School Funding Plan, as introduced in the Ohio House as House Bill 1.
- Approved a resolution for Graduation Flexibility for the Class of 2021.
- Employed the following new certified staff on a one-year limited contract, effective August 26, 2021:

- Approved Jeffrey Starkey as a credentialed teacher evaluator under the Ohio Teacher Evaluation System through March 22, 2023.
- Approved the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys track athletic supplemental for 2020-2021 spring season.
