Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, April 11, 2022, in the Band Room at the Complex, and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the March 14, 2022 Regular Board Meeting.
- Approved the March Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the Fiscal Year 2023 Excess Costs Foundation Contract with the Trumbull County ESC.
- Approved the resignation of Christine Wevers, a certified staff member, effective at the conclusion of the 2021-2022 school year.
- Approved a one-year leave of absence for two certified staff members, during the 2022-2023 school year, per Article XII, Section G of the negotiated agreement with the LaBrae Teachers' Association.
- Approved an unpaid medical leave of absence for a classified employee, per Article VII, Section C of the OAPSE Local 278 negotiated agreement.
- Approved a reduction in force, in accord with O.R.C. 3319.172 and Article XVII of the negotiated agreement between the Board and OAPSE Local 278, within the transportation classification reducing the number of mechanics from two to one due to the decreasing student population, and subsequently in compliance with Article XVII of the negotiated agreement, lay off a mechanic and suspend the employment contract effective July 1, 2022.
- Approved the LaBrae High School Band trip to Hershey Park/Gettysburg from May 8, 2022 through May 9, 2022, which will be chaperoned by Erin Ott and Stephanie Pavlovich.
- Approved the Memorandum of Understanding, with Youngstown State University, for the College Credit Plus program, which allows secondary school students to enroll in college level courses to receive college credit during the 2022-2023 school year.
- Approved additional classified substitutes for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year.
- Accepted the resignation of Mara Kujala from the 2021-2022 athletic supplemental position of 7th & 8th grade girls track, effective immediately.
- Approved athletic supplemental positions for Winter Physical Fitness, Boys Assistant Track Coach and 7th & 8th grade Girls Track Coach.
- Approved the facility request for the LaBrae Scout Alumni Association to hold their annual craft show on Saturday, November 5, 2022 with setup occurring on Friday, November 4, 2022.
- Approved a first reading of a Board Policy addition, revisions and rescission.
- Heard the following concerns of the Board:
 - 1) A motion by Mr. Gibson to declare that the LaBrae 6th Grade camp program as a co-curricular program and an extension of the classroom activities, and therefore, only students enrolled in the LaBrae School system be allowed to participate in those activities associated with that program.
 - 2) A motion by Mr. Gamlin to individually recognize all student achievements during the monthly school board meetings.
 - 3) A motion by Mr. Morton to make an exception for 6th grade student(s) who reside in the LaBrae Local School District, regardless of enrollment status, to be able to participate in the 6th grade camping program for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Entered into executive session to discuss employee compensation and collective bargaining.
