Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, August 13, 2018, in the Library at Bascom Elementary, and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the July 9, 2018 Regular Board Meeting and the July 16, 2018 Special Board Meeting.
- Approved the July Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the payment of July Bills as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the contract with Second Harvest Food Bank of the Mahoning Valley to establish a food pantry at LaBrae Schools under Second Harvest's School Pantry Partner Program.
- Accepted the resignation of Amy Rutherford, a certified employee, effective August 15, 2018.
- Employed Olga Best as the secretary to the treasurer, on a one-year limited contract, effective August 13, 2018.
- Approved Pauline Stone as a transportation driver for students participating in the summer intervention programs, from August 6, 2018 through August 17, 2018, which was paid through a charitable donation.
- Approved the contract termination for an employee whose return rights have expired, effective July 31, 2018.
- Approved payment in lieu of transportation for a student attending a private school.
- Approved Amy Frederick as an Ohio Department of Education Credentialed Teacher Evaluator valid through July 18, 2020.
