Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, February 13, 2023, in the Complex Band Room and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the January 9, 2023 Regular Board Meeting.
- Approved the January Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the increase in the daily contractual work hours of the Secretary to the Treasurer position from 6.5 daily hours to 8 hours daily, effective March 1, 2023, and extend all rights, privileges and benefits afforded under the negotiated agreement between this Board and OAPSE Local 278.
- Approved the employment of Margie Adair, as a substitute school counselor for grades K-5, on an as needed basis, at a per diem rate of \$200.00, effective January 23, 2023.
- Accepted the resignation letter, for retirement purposes, of Kay Suzelis, Intermediate Principal, with the last date of employment of June 30, 2023.
- Approved an extension of the Family Medical Leave of Absence for a classified staff member, effective January 17, 2023 through February 10, 2023.
- Approved a classified employee, a six-month medical leave of absence in accordance with Article VII of the OAPSE 278 negotiated agreement from February 13, 2023 through August 13, 2023.
- Approved a Family Medical Leave of Absence for a certified staff member, effective January 9, 2023 through March 31, 2023.
- Approved a student for senior rights status for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year, effective January 30, 2023, per Ohio Revised Code 3313.64.
- Approved Kenedi Cross as a permanent substitute, at the per diem substitute rate, effective February 3, 2023.
- Approved Jessica Tilton, as a non-certified substitute, at the daily sub rate on an as needed basis for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year, effective January 18, 2023.
- Employed Lynn Rider as an instructional tutor/paraprofessional, not to exceed five and a half (5.5) hours per day, or 29.5 hours in a week, at the rate of \$17.27 per hour, for the 2022-2023 school year, with work days to be determined by the availability of funding, effective February 10, 2023.
- Approved a five-year contract for internet services with NEOMIN, effective July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2028 for the following locations: Bascom Elementary, LaBrae Intermediate School, LaBrae Middle School, LaBrae High School and LaBrae Transportation Buildings.
- Approved Mathews Photography as the district photographer for athletics and student activities for the 2023-2024 school year.
- Approved the 2022-2023 cafeteria ala carte pricing as submitted by the cafeteria supervisor.
- Approved a pupil transportation agreement regarding transportation services for high school student, effective November 1, 2022.
- Approved the 2023-2024 Academic School Calendar.
- Approved continuation of the Inter-District Open Enrollment Policy and Guideline for the LaBrae Local School District for the 2023-2024 school year, for open enrollment students from all other districts.
- Approved the 2023-2024 Academic Handbook for LaBrae High School.
- Approved the Memorandums of Understanding for the College Credit Plus program, which will allow secondary school students to enroll in college level courses to receive college credit during the 2023-2024 school year, with the following higher level educational institution: Kent State University and Youngstown State University
