Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, July 13, 2020, in the Complex Band Room, and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the June 8, 2020 Regular Board Meeting and the June 26, 2020 Special Board Meeting.
- Approved the June Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the payment of June Bills as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved change orders from Murphy Contracting Co. for the Bascom Remodeling project.
- Approved Landers-Lewis Insurance Agency as a provider of insurance coverage for the District from September 1, 2020 through September 1, 2021 for \$59,996.00.
- Approved the Student Activity Account Budgets as presented by the Treasurer.
- Accepted the Permanent Annual Appropriations as presented by the Treasurer for fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.
- Approved an administrative contract with Bradley Panak, Treasurer, effective August 1, 2020 through July 31, 2021.
- Approved an unpaid medical leave of absence for a classified employee, per the OAPSE Local 278 negotiated agreement, effective June 11, 2020 through August 2, 2020.
- Approved an extension of a medical leave of absence, originally approved in resolution number 568-19, for a classified employee, through June 30, 2021, which is in accord with Article VII of the OAPSE Local 278 negotiated agreement.
- Approved a resolution authorizing membership in the Ohio Coalition for Equity and Adequacy of School Funding.
- Approved the 2020-2021 LaBrae Gifted Policy and Plan for the Identification & Services of Gifted Students.
- Approved academic supplemental contracts for the technology assistant positions for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Adopted student handbooks for Bascom Elementary, LaBrae Intermediate and LaBrae Middle School for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Approved employment of substitute teachers and tutors as needed from the list provided by the Trumbull County Educational Service Center for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Adopted a resolution stating the Board will not provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Approved Great Lakes Biomedical as the student drug testing vendor for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Approved a second reading of and subsequent adoption of Board Policy addition, replacement and revisions.
