Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, July 12, 2021, in the Complex Auditorium and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the June 14, 2021 Regular Board Meeting and the June 29, 2021 Special Board Meeting.
- Approved the June Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the creation of new federally funded programs for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Approved the return of the \$70,000.00 advance from the ARP ESSER III Fund (507/9023) back to the General Fund (001).
- Approved membership in the Ohio Coalition for Equity and Adequacy of School Funding and authorized the payment of membership dues.
- Approved the Memorandum of Understanding with the LaBrae Teachers' Association on extended learning.
- Accepted the resignation of classified employee, Keith Ferry, a bus driver, due to retirement effective August 23, 2021.
- Approved Anthony J. Calderone and Martin Kelly as credentialed teacher evaluators under the Ohio Teacher Evaluation System.
- Adopted a resolution stating the Board will not provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for the 2021-2022 school year.

- Approved employment of substitute teachers and tutors as needed from the list provided by the Trumbull County Educational Service Center for the 2021-2022 school year.
