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Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, July 11, 2022, in the Complex Auditorium and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the June 13, 2022 Regular Board Meeting and the June 27, 2022 Special Board Meeting.
- Approved the June Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved advances back to the General Fund.
- Approved the investment into the two CD's.
- Approved Student Protective Agency as the agency to service LaBrae families, on a voluntary basis, for student accident coverage during the 2022-2023 school year.
- Approved the termination of a certified contract due to a STRS leave of absence for five years and the return rights per Ohio Revised Code have expired.
- Approved a resolution declaring transportation to be impractical for three non-public students and offered payment in-lieu.
- Approved the resignation for the following supplementals: Band Director - Elementary - 5th grade, Band Director - Elementary - 6th grade, Band Director - 7th & 8th Grade, Assistant Varsity Band Director + Summer Duties
- Employed Alison Deagan as a Special Education Interventionist at Bascom Elementary School, on a one-year limited contract.
- Employed Eric Elmore as a Special Education Interventionist at LaBrae High School, on a one-year limited contract.
- Employed Miranda Gerchak as an Instrumental and Vocal Teacher at LaBrae Intermediate and Middle School, on a one-year limited contract.
- Employed Tracy Harp as the library aide at LaBrae Intermediate School, on a one-year limited contract.
- Employed Beth Kennedy as a bus driver, on a one-year limited contract.
- Approved voluntary transfers of certified staff members for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Approved an additional classified substitute.
- Approved the membership in the Ohio Coalition for Equity and Adequacy of School Funding and authorized the payment of membership dues.
- Approved the negotiated agreement with OAPSE Local 278, effective July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025.
- Approved the application of the negotiated provisions and remunerations of the OAPSE Local 278 collective bargaining agreement, effective July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2025, to certain classified administrative positions in FY2023 through FY2025.
- Approved the FY2023 contract with the Trumbull ESC for public relations/communications support.
- Approved the school resource officer agreement with the Warren Township Board of Trustees and Warren Township Police Chief, effective for FY2023 and FY2024.
- Approved Anthony J. Calderone as Lead Mentor at 2.25% of Base Salary (BA Step 0) of the certified salary schedule of the negotiated agreement between the Board of Education and the LaBrae Teachers' Association for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Approved a special education instructional tutor, on an as needed basis, at the substitute per diem rate, for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Approved a substitute nurse on an as needed basis, to be paid from American Rescue Plan funds, effective August 1, 2022 through June 2, 2023.
- Adopted a resolution stating the Board will not provide career-technical education to students enrolled in grades seven and eight for the 2022-2023 school year.

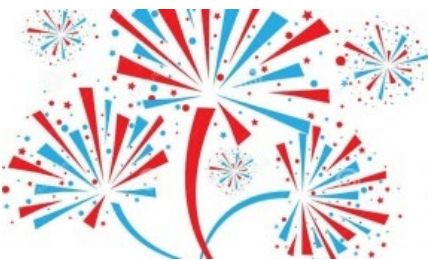
