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Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, March 8, 2021, in the Complex Auditorium, and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the February 8, 2021 Regular Board Meeting.
- Approved the February Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Approved the 507 / 9022 ESSER (Elementary & Secondary School Emergency Relief) Fund and allocation amount.
- Approved a transfer from the General Fund (001) to the Athletic Fund (300 / 9500).
- Adopted the Alternative Tax Budget Information for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021.
