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Greetings: The LaBrae BOE held their regular monthly meeting Monday, September 12, 2022, in the Complex Band Room and conducted the following business:

- Approved the minutes of the August 8, 2022 Regular Board Meeting.
- Approved the August Financial Report as presented by the Treasurer.
- Accepted the Permanent Annual Appropriations as presented by the Treasurer for fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.
- Approved the Amended Certificate of Estimated Resources as presented by the Treasurer for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.
- Accepted the resignation of a bus driver, effective August 9, 2022.
- Accepted the resignation of a Title I Tutor/Paraprofessional, effective August 26, 2022.
- Approved a Family Medical Leave of Absence for a certified staff member, effective August 29, 2022 through October 14, 2022.
- Approved the supplemental contract for Margaret Kowach as the CCIP Coordinator for the fiscal year 2022-2023.
- Approved additional Title I Tutors/Instructional Tutors/Paraprofessionals, not to exceed five and a half (5.5) hours per day, or 29.5 hours in a week, for the 2022-2023 school year, with work days to be determined by the availability of Federal funding.
- Approved a non-certified substitute, at the daily sub rate on an as needed basis for the 2022-2023 school year, effective August 31, 2022.
- Approved employment for a certified staff member in the summer extended learning program, at \$35.00 an hour to be paid with ARP funds with hours determined by the Superintendent.
- Approved the bus routes for the 2022-2023 school year, and authorize the superintendent, or Superintendent Designee, to make changes throughout the year as necessary.
- Approved a resolution declaring transportation to be impractical for one non-public student and offered payment in-lieu.
- Approved the tuition rate of \$3,850.08 for the 2022-2023 school year as set by the State of Ohio's Department of Education Office of Budget and School Funding.
- Approved Anthony J. Calderone as a Credentialed Principal Evaluator under the Ohio Teacher Evaluation System, effective August 30, 2022 through August 30, 2024.
- Approved supplemental stipends to certified employees who are serving as mentor teachers in the Ohio Resident Educator Program for the 2022-2023 school year, as per Article XVIII, Section E of the negotiated agreement between the Board of Education and the LaBrae Teachers' Association.
