
## MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parent/Guardians: Due to the holiday season and the shortness of the month of December, I have decided to combine December and January's newsletter. Dental sealants for participating 6th grade students beginning December 2nd and will end on December 12th. We had a great turn out for parent-teacher conferences night. I would like to thank of all of you for making parent-teacher conferences a success.
