A Message from the Principal:

START WITH HELLO

February 11 – 15th, students will be taking part in **Start With Hello Week** at LaBrae Intermediate. Start with Hello teaches students, the skills they need to reach out to and include those who may be dealing with chronic social isolation and create a culture of inclusion and connectedness within their classroom, school, and community.

We encourage you to talk to your child about the **Start With Hello** program and ask them to share what they have learned. Not only will that help you learn how to support your child to see isolation, reach out and connect, and Start With Hello, it also demonstrates to your child that you take this subject seriously and can support them in their actions to create a more connected and inclusive home, classroom, school and community.

The week will include three themes. Monday is *Hey Day*, student will wear a name tag and be encouraged to call others by their first name in the hall, lunch and classroom. Tuesday is *Vikings Wear Green to put a Go on Saying Hello*. Wednesday is *You are a Super Hero Day*, students are encouraged to wear something that represents their “Super Power.” This can include a super hero t-shirt, sports apparel, favorite movie, favorite character or graphic/words that positively promote themselves or their interests. Students will also receive a **Start With Hello** bracelet and sticker. The week will conclude with National “No One Eats Alone Day” at lunch.

From the Attendance Department:

Attendance is a very important aspect of your child's education. Many times parents fail to realize the number of days missed. It must be pointed out that attendance may be used as a basis for promotion or retention. LaBrae Board Policy states: A student who is absent from school more than nine (9) days in one semester or more than eighteen (18) days in one year would be subject to loss of credit respectively. All absences, whether excused or unexcused and suspensions will be counted. **We request that parents notify the school by telephone (330) 898-4569 the morning of the absence and follow up with a written excuse.** It is the responsibility of the student to obtain make-up work following an absence. **There will a 2% reduction of the nine-weeks grades for each day unexcused or suspended. A call & note from the parents must be received within a 24 hour period to excuse an absence.**

Cold and flu season is here. Just a reminder that if your child is ill, please keep them at home until they are free from fever, vomiting or diarrhea for a full 24 hours.
