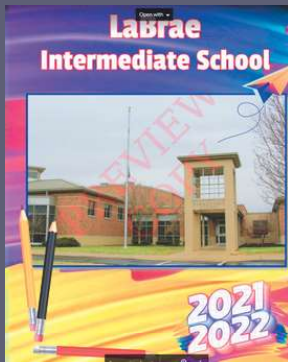

Natural Hair Coloring

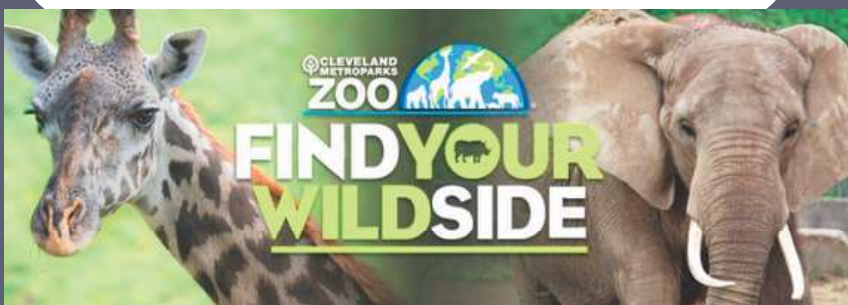

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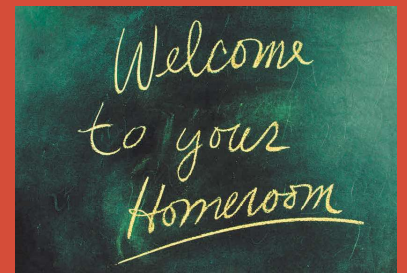

To receive free or reduced lunch pricing, families must fill out *Free & Reduced Lunch Application* on Final Forms. There is NO Free lunch this year for all students! You must apply to be eligible. Check the box that shares information with other school officials to determine eligibility for waiving instructional fees.

School Fees

School Fees for K-5 will be \$50. (\$40.00 Workbook Fee and \$10.00 Technology Fee) Grade 4 also has a \$3.75 fee for recorders. 5th grade band fees as assigned by the band director.

Alternate Busing

At the beginning of the school year, students are bused to and from their HOME address. If you need an alternate pick up or drop off site, a "Request for Alternate Busing" must be filled out. It must be completed 48 hours in advance of any change.

There will be only one alternate busing request allowed per year and the request is permanent Monday - Friday.

New for the 2022-23 School year, if the number of calamity days exceed 5 days, any additional snow/calamity days will be remote learning. The students would access Google Classroom & join Google Meets according to the following schedule, which is the same remote schedule used during Covid remote learning days.

Step	Violation	Response/Consequence
1	First	Warning (unless a more serious violation- then consequence advances to Step 2)
2	Second	Detention
3	Thlrd	Parent meeting with Driver LIS-Saturday Detention
4	Fourth	1-3 Day Bus Suspension (depending on the violatlon)
5	Fifth	3-5 Day Bus Suspension (depending on the violation)
6	Further Incidents	10 Day Bus Suspension & Meeting with the Transportation Supervisor to determine the continuation or suspension of bus transportation,

The principals may at his/her discretion revise, amend or adapt this disciplinary response as conditions warrant based on severity and frequency of offenses.
