### **SAFETY FIRST!!!**

For the safety of all, ALL VISITORS MUST SIGN IN AT THE OFFICE upon entering the building & obtain a pass to proceed to any other area of the building. All Teachers have a planning period each day. If you wish to speak or meet with them, please call ahead to make an appointment. Parents/Guardians may not interrupt the Teacher during class time.
