

The January 8, 2018 organizational meeting of the LaBrae Board of Education was called to order by Mr. Sewell, President Pro-temp.

Mrs. Jones administered the oath of office to Mr. Gibson and Mrs. Duncan.

The meeting was held at 5:30 p.m. in the Complex Band Room. Members present on roll call: Mr. Sewell, Mr. Gibson, Mrs. Duncan, Mrs. Blaney and Mr. Morton. Also present were Mr. Anthony Calderone, Superintendent and Mrs. Carol Jones, Treasurer.

Mr. Gibson nominated Mr. Sewell for President of the Board. Mrs. Blaney seconded the nomination. There being no other nominations for President, nominations were closed.

Mrs. Duncan nominated Mrs. Blaney for Vice President of the Board. Mr. Morton seconded the nomination. There being no other nominations for Vice President, nominations were closed.

The Treasurer called the roll for votes: Mr. Sewell, Mr. Gibson, Mrs. Duncan, Mrs. Blaney and Mr. Morton voted YES. Mr. Sewell won the vote for President and Mrs. Blaney won the vote for Vice President.

Mr. Sewell appointed the following members to serve:

Motion by Mrs. Blaney seconded by Mr. Morton to set the date for Regular Board meetings as follows:

Date – Second Monday of the Month (other than November, which will be the Third Monday of the Month (November 19, 2018)

Time – 6:00 PM

Location – LaBrae Complex Band Room or Bascom Library

Roll call: Mrs. Blaney, Mr. Morton, Mrs. Duncan, Mr. Gibson and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Duncan seconded by Mr. Gibson to set bond for Treasurer at \$50,000.00 payable to the State of Ohio and the bond set for the Superintendent and President of the Board of Education at \$50,000.00 payable to the LaBrae Board of Education. Roll call: Mrs. Duncan, Mr. Gibson, Mrs. Blaney, Mr. Morton and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Morton seconded by Mrs. Duncan to authorize the Treasurer to secure advances on tax settlements from the County Auditor when funds are available and payable to the school district. Roll call: Mr. Morton, Mrs. Duncan, Mrs. Blaney, Mr. Gibson and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Blaney seconded by Mr. Morton to authorize the Treasurer to invest inactive funds at the most productive interest rate whenever inactive funds are available. Roll call: Mrs. Blaney, Mr. Morton, Mrs. Duncan, Mr. Gibson and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Duncan seconded by Mr. Morton to authorize the Treasurer to pay all bills within limits of the appropriations resolution as bills are received and when the merchandise has been received in good condition. Roll call: Mrs. Duncan, Mr. Morton, Mr. Gibson, Mrs. Blaney and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Gibson seconded by Mrs. Duncan to authorize the Superintendent to employ such temporary personnel as are needed for emergency situations. Such employment to be presented for approval by the Board at the next regular meeting. Roll call: Mr. Gibson, Mrs. Duncan, Mrs. Blaney, Mr. Morton and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Duncan seconded by Mr. Gibson that the members of the LaBrae Board of Education shall be compensated at the maximum rate authorized by law. Maximum of 12 meetings per year. Roll call: Mrs. Duncan, Mr. Gibson, Mrs. Blaney, Mr. Morton and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Morton seconded by Mrs. Blaney to designate the Warren Tribune Chronicle as the official newspaper for publications. Roll call: Mr. Morton, Mrs. Blaney, Mrs. Duncan, Mr. Gibson and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Blaney seconded by Mrs. Duncan to authorize the Treasurer to establish a Service Fund. Roll call: Mrs. Blaney, Mrs. Duncan, Mr. Morton, Mr. Gibson and Mr. Sewell voted YES. Motion carried.

Motion by Mrs. Blaney seconded by Mrs. Duncan to adopt the following resolution:

SECTION ONE: The legal services of the law firms as specified herein are hereby retained for 2017. Such legal services are to be in the nature of legal representation, including appearances in court, advice, opinions and recommendations as may from time to time be requested by this Board or the Superintendent as to legal matters relating to education. In rendering such legal services, as an independent contractor, and in an attorney-client relationship, said firm shall not exercise any administrative discretion on behalf of this Board in the formulation of public policy, expenditure of public funds, enforcement of laws, rules and regulations of the State, any country, or cities of this Board, or the execution of public trusts. The retention of such services may be terminated at any time by the Board or said firms by written notice to the other.

SECTION TWO: For such legal services, said Legal Services Approved List, fees and costs for such services shall be at the usual and customary rates for the professional services rendered upon receipt of an itemized statement by the school district Treasurer; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, such legal services shall be available on-call, on demand, and at the request of the Board President and the Superintendent, with informed notice provided to all board members.
