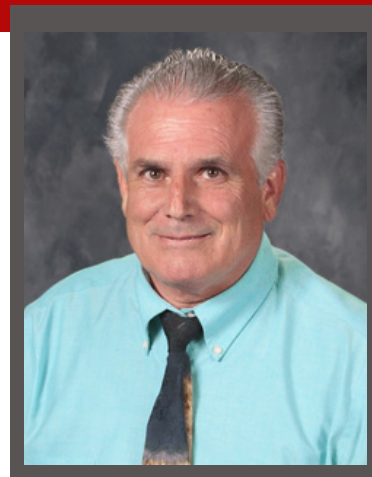

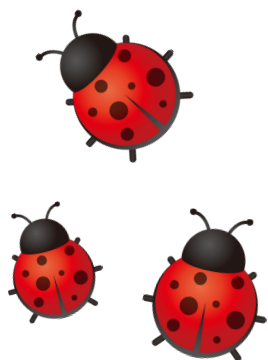

April 17 th - ELA Part II

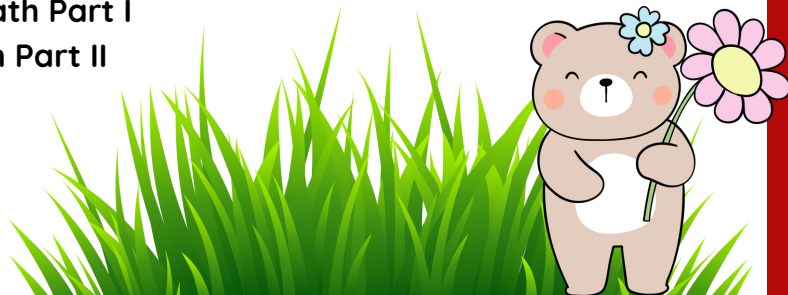
