Dear Parent/Guardians:

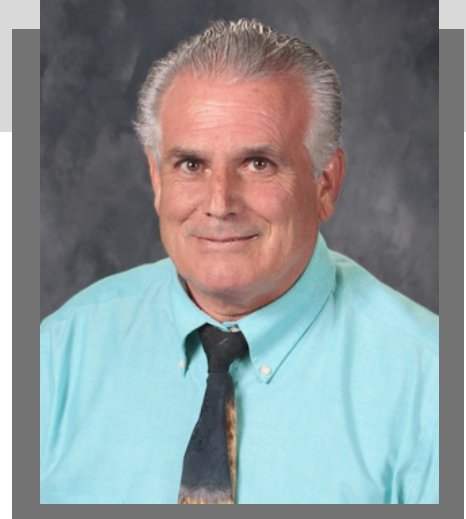
Interims were sent home with the students on September 29. Hopefully, everyone had the opportunity to review the interim with your student. I encourage every parent, regardless of your child's academic standing, to schedule a conference for October 13, the first of the two P.T. Conferences that the district holds for parents. This is the best opportunity for parents to sit down with our teaching staff at the grade level of your child. Middle school conferences are set up at 15-minute intervals and will run from 2 to 9 p.m. Middle school students will be released at noon on that day. School will also not be in session for students on October 28 for an in-service for staff.

The 6th-grade class holds two major fundraisers throughout the school year. The fundraisers are held to offset the cost of 6th-grade camp in May. Mr. Hinzman organizes and runs the annual car show in August. Mr. Bailey organizes and runs the annual mum sale. The fundraisers are successful due to the community supporting them. We would like to again thank the LaBrae community for your continued support on a yearly basis. The middle school will also hold a fundraiser in the spring. All proceeds are returned to the building and are used to support the students. Last year was the best fundraiser we ever had in the last 13 years. Once again, that's due to community support.

The middle school has been conducting Benchmark Testing that is aligned with state standards. These benchmarks are designed to determine the level where the student is currently working at. The test establishes a point of comparison from the beginning of instruction to the end of instruction. These benchmarks and checkpoints will be conducted periodically throughout the year heading towards the state test that begin in late March/April.

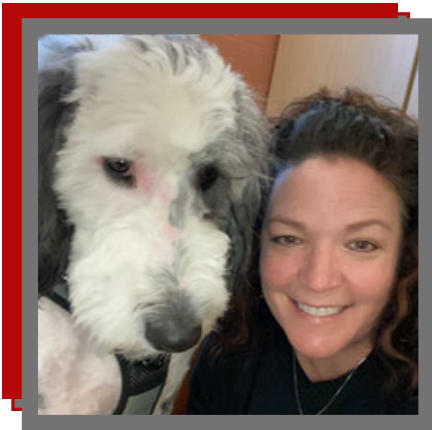
