MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parent/Guardians: There are quite a few things happening during the month of October in the middle school. On October 6th, we will hold our annual picture day. Students will be called down by grade level to have their pictures taken. Parents may wish to purchase student pictures and that information has been sent home with students. There will be no school on October 16th due to NEOEA Day. The dental sealant staff will meet with our 6th grade students on October 19th. I will call all 6th grade students to the auditorium to review the process of dental sealants. This service is offered free of charge to any 6th grade student. Following the meeting, information will be sent home explaining the process along with permission slips should you choose to have this service done. The 1st grading period will end October 23rd with students being released at noon. Report cards will be sent home with students on October 30th.

State law requires that all 7th grade students provide documentation of their T-dap booster shot. Last May, the 6th grade students were called down to the auditorium to remind them about their T-dap shot record. I called numerous students to the auditorium on September 28th that do not have their T-dap record on file. These students were given a form describing what is needed, and then they can go and get their shot. The original cut off date is September 30th, but I have extended this date until October 15th. I can not extend it any longer due to state law. I ask that you comply with this ASAP.

That's all I have for now. It's hard to believe we are already in October. Best wishes.

NURSE NEWS

Parents, some students are still missing the following items:

7th graders: Proof of a T-dap booster was due on 9-30. Students were given information on this last May. Several notices have been sent home. This is a requirement of the state. Please send in your proof of T-dap, if you have not already done so.

Clinic forms: Any forms regarding asthma/allergies etc. were to be turned in at the beginning of the school year. Students requiring prescription medication (inhaler/epi-pens etc.) are required to have a doctor's order for the medication every year. This is a state and district requirement. Forms were mailed home in June to any student known to have a potential medical issue. A response is required. If you need new forms, your student may pick them up in the clinic.
