LABRAE BUS RULES

- 1. Obey the bus driver's instructions; Be cooperative.
- 2. Observe classroom conduct while on the bus.
- 3. Stay seated in your assigned seat.
- 4. Do not block the aisle way with your legs/feet, book bags, musical instruments or other items. If an emergency should arise, it is important to have the aisle clear of obstruction.
- 5. Do not yell or make loud noises that could distract the driver. You are permitted to talk quietly.
- 6. Never put your head, hands or arms out of the school bus window.
- 7. Do not throw things at others on the bus or out of the bus windows.
- 8. Be kind to everyone.
- 9. Do not fight, push, or shove others.
- 10. Do not use profanity.
- 11. Keep the bus clean, pick up after yourself.
- 12. Do not do damage to the school bus or equipment.
- 13. Do not eat or drink while on the bus.
- 14. Do not touch or play with the emergency exits.
- 15. Flammable items are prohibited from being on the bus.
- 16. The bus driver reserves the right to reassign your seat.

Note: Violation of the rules subjects a student to disciplinary measures. Should a student consistently violate the rules they will be subject to losing transportation privileges.
