There is an ongoing conversation within the district concerning returning all students on March 29th. March 29th is the 1st day of the final 9 weeks of this school year. The district is currently offering vaccinations for all employees wanting one, The first round was held on February 26th, the second round will be held roughly 3 weeks from then. Please pay attention to any communications coming from the superintendent's office concerning a potential return to school. This is our goal to get everyone back, Hopefully by the next school year we will return to some state of normalcy.

I want to thank those parents that took advantage of our PT conference night held on February 11th. Your participation in making a conference does have an impact on the students, I realize that this pandemic has changed a lot of things that once were normal. We need to struggle through this together hopefully the end is in sight.

The State of Ohio at this moment is still planning to conduct state testing for all students. This can change but the district must prepare for testing. The state has extended the testing window for content areas by 1 week each. The actual windows for testing are ELA 3/22-4/30, Math/Science 3/29-5/14. LaBrae will not start testing until April. I will provide additional information concerning testing in the April newsletter. There will be an early dismissal at noon on March 26. The 6th & 7th grade camping experience is still being explored.
