MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

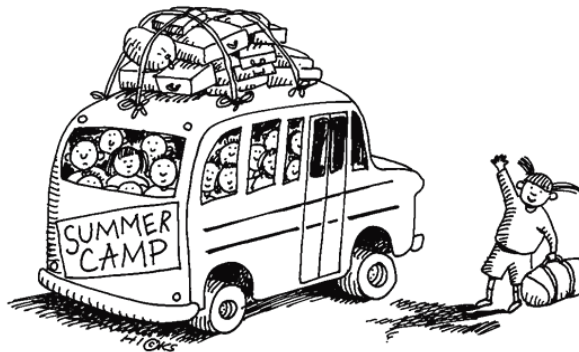
Dear Parent/Guardians:
