You may drop off forms and medications starting August 19, 2019 prior to the first day of school for students. **Students entering kindergarten** who did not have an up to date shot record at the time of registration should also return their shot records to the collection box in **the Bascom Office**. **Students entering 7th grade** need to have documentation of having received their **Td, Tdap booster shot and Meningitis Vaccine**. **Any student entering 12th Grade also needs a Meningitis Vaccine**. Having these forms in place when school starts is essential in helping us keep your children safe at school. Thank you for your cooperation!
