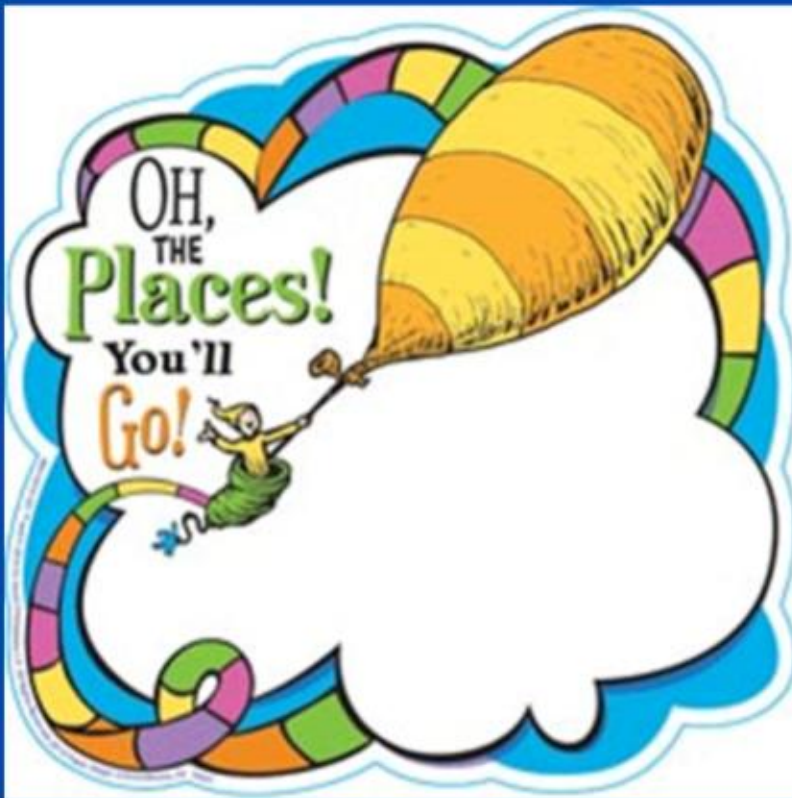
Senior Video January 5 - May 6, 2026
