## DRESS CODE

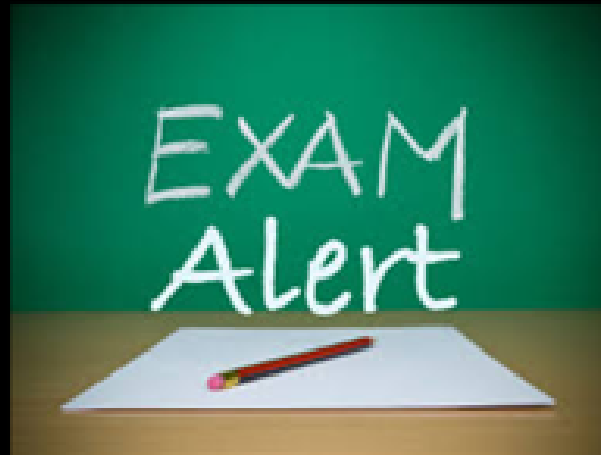
As the weather breaks, be aware of appropriate attire for school...

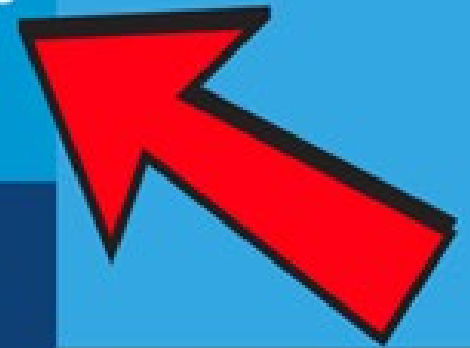
