We will have our first meeting next **Wednesday, September 17** during lunch in the teacher's lounge across from the band room.

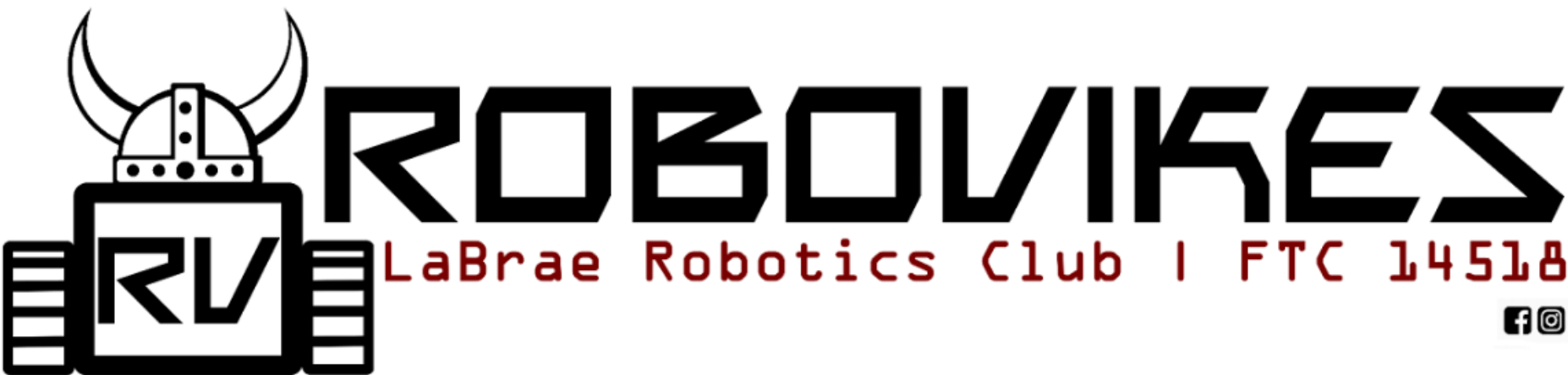

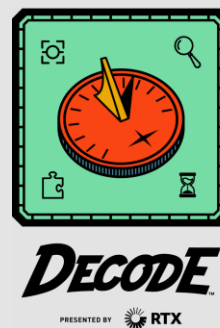
