# ITEMS OF INTEREST



## Suicide Facts...

### General Facts

1. Among those who commit suicide, more than 90% are suffering from depression.
2. It is the 10th leading cause of death in the US for all ages.
3. Every day, approximately 123 Americans die by suicide.
4. That is 44,965 Americans a year.

### Gender

1. Suicide among males is 4x's higher than among females.
2. Females experience depression at roughly 2x's the rate of men..
3. Firearms are the most commonly used method of suicide among males.
4. Poisoning is the most common method of suicide for females.

### Age

1. 1 in 100,000 children ages 10 to 14 die by suicide each year.
2. 7 in 100,000 youth ages 15 to 19 die by suicide each year.
3. 12.7 in 100,000 in young adults ages 20 to 24 die by suicide each year.
4. Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for 15 to 24 year old Americans.
