MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parent/Guardians:

The middle school had a strong showing of parents during our first round of P-T Conferences. Conferences were held on October 11th from 2-9 pm. There were 78 fifteen minute slots available for grades 6-8 and parents filled 65 of those 78 slots. That was a strong showing, and we would like to thank those parents that were able to attend. Please keep in mind that the district only has two conference days per year.

During the month of October, we held a practice lock-down drill on the 2nd and a fire-drill on the 30th. The school nurse also completed vision screening on our 7th grade students on the 8th. Dental sealants for the 6th grade students that returned permission forms will begin November 26th and will be completed on December 4th. The district will also be holding a lock-down drill on November 15th. The drill will be supported by the WTPD. We drill monthly on fire and tornado responses. The district is also using the Navigate app for lockdown purposes. The App allows staff members to take attendance on their phones, so that every child can be accounted for. This app is new to the district and that's why we are having more lockdown drills, so that staff can become familiar using the app.

Report cards went home with the students on November 2nd. There will be no school for students on the 6th. Thanksgiving break will begin November 21st with students returning on November 26th. Interims will be sent home on November 28th. I think that's all for now.
