SAFETY FIRST!!!

For the safety of all,

- <u>ALL VISITORS MUST SIGN IN AT THE OFFICE</u> upon entering the building & obtain a pass to proceed to any other
 area of the building. All Teachers have a planning period each day. If you wish to speak or meet with them, please
 call ahead to make an appointment. Parents/Guardians may not interrupt the Teacher during class time.
- ARRIVAL When dropping off students in the morning, the following procedures should be followed:
 - Drop student off directly in front of the entrance and exit the vehicle only on the passenger side.
 <u>DO NOT DROP STUDENTS OFF IN THE PARKING LOT</u>, unless they are accompanied by you into the office to sign them in.
 - 2. <u>IF YOUR CHILD IS COMING TO SCHOOL AFTER 8:45 A.M. YOU MUST COME INTO THE OFFICE AND SIGN THEM IN. YOU CANNOT JUST DROP THEM OFF!!</u>
- DEPARTURE—The official school day ends at 3:25 p.m.
- 1. Parents picking children up on a regular basis(2 days or more a week) must fill out a

 Permanent Pick Up Form and sign students out at the Event Entrance located at the back of the complex between 3:15 and 3:25 pm.
 - 2. Phone call requests cannot be accommodated. Last minute changes will not be accommodated.
 - 3. Parents picking up children at the end of the day, less than two times a week, are asked to report to the office between 3:10p.m. and 3:20p.m. to sign their child out and wait there until their child is dismissed via the intercom to meet you.
