



Your child needs an eye exam!

The results of a school vision screening show that your child may have trouble seeing. Good vision is important for your child to do well in school. Below are three ways your child can access vision care:

> YOUR CHILD PARTICIPATES IN THE VISION TO LEARN PROGRAM

You can have your child participate in the Vision To Learn program. The routine eye exam and glasses are provided at no cost! Vision To Learn will provide vision services to your child unless you have completed AND returned an Opt-Out Letter. If would like to decline services, please contact your school nurse.

Here's how the program works:

- 1. The Vision To Learn mobile clinic is an eye doctor's office on wheels. It will visit your child's school.
- 2. A licensed independent eye doctor will provide your child a routine eye exam. The results of the eye exam will be shared with you.
- 3. If needed, your child will pick out glasses frames.
- 4. Glasses will be delivered 3 weeks later.
- 5. If applicable, vision services provided will be billed to your child's Medicaid benefits.

CONTINUE CARE WITH YOUR LOCAL EYECARE PROVIDER

If your child already has an eye doctor and you do not need vision services from Vision To Learn, please complete the Opt-Out Letter or contact your school nurse to opt out of the program. We encourage you to return to your doctor for continued vision care services. To find an eye doctor near you, call the 1-800 number on the back of your child's insurance card. If your child has Medicaid, the eye exam and glasses are covered by your insurance!

MY CHILD HAS A VALID PRESCRIPTION AND WE NEED ASSISTANCE WITH GLASSES ONLY

If your child has received recent care from an eye doctor, and your child needs a pair of eyeglasses, then please provide a valid prescription (exam within 12 months) from your child's eye doctor or clinic to your school nurse. External prescriptions should be returned within two weeks of this letter.

Vision To Learn will help your child as follows:

- 1. Your child will choose a new frame from Vision To Learn.
- 2. Vision To Learn will order new glasses with the prescription provided.
- 3. A licensed Optician will distribute the eye glasses to your school within 3-4 weeks from your child's fitting.
